# **New Computer Service at the Village Hall**

A new Computer Help service is being provided at the Village Hall and will start on Wednesday 11th July and Wednesday 25th July commencing at 10am until midday. The service is to provide Computer help, support and advice to those who have a need for system understanding, training, computer repair, software development or any other computer related issue. The first session will focus on Internet Security and how to Speed Up your computer as these issues have proven to be of concern to many residents.

The Village Hall Committee are providing the first two sessions free and there will be no admission charge on either of these sessions. If you would like to attend, please telephone Brian Meadows at Nofix-Nofee

Computer Services on 01288 381061 and register your interest and details of a question or computing problem you may have and want answered or email buzz@nofix-nofee.net Repairs cannot be undertaken at either of these sessions, but some remedial work may be possible.

On May 1st, Microsoft released an upgrade to the windows 10 program. This upgrade is in excess of 3 Gb of data and has already caused several problems for local residents. Users on a restricted data allowance may find they exceed that allowance incurring "out of plan" penalty charges. To help avoid this charge, Nofix-Nofee Computer Services will provide a DVD with the relevant upgrade ready for external installation, this upgrade will only work on machines which have Windows 10 presently installed with a digital key-code, it is not free Windows 10 unlicensed software.


There has also been an increase in Tracking Software, these monitor all your computer activity, even after you have closed the browser down and send that information to a server somewhere in the world, which will then be sold to a 3rd party and/or used to steal from you.

The Home Library Service is delivered by the Royal Voluntary Service (who some may still recall as the WRVS) on behalf of Devon Libraries. around 37 of the 50 libraries in Devon teams of volunteers with a co-ordinator lead deliver books to over 300 'readers' in the county. Despite this number I remain convinced there are people who are lonely and isolated and could use our service yet don't know about it. We deliver to those who through ill health, mobility issues, or caring responsibilities cannot get to the library, this may be a temporary arrangement or more long term. I have visited libraries where I have met someone who uses the service, however due to their illness feel fit enough some days to visit whereas on others they would struggle. It may be they cannot carry books back or can order on line but cannot collect them. We can provide that service.

The service is completely free, there are no fines incurred and no cost to ordering books. Provision can be of large print, normal print, audio books or cd's if it is music you prefer.
