BRIDGERULE OPEN SPACE GROUP.

Can you help us?

Bridgerule Parish Council are planning to renovate and improve the land known as Southfields Open Space in early 2025 and make it accessible again as a green space for the village. The council are engaging the services of a contractor to clear the site initially to enable safe access to the site. New Fencing for the area is being looked at as the project progresses.

It is hoped to form a group of volunteers to assist and maintain the area, backed up using contractor services where needed and timely. The group will be headed by a designated Councillor of the Parish council, Mr. Fred Cogdell.

It is hoped to run sessions on a monthly basis. The sessions will not last more than two hours and will operate on a drop-in basis, no formal commitment needed, just come when you are able to. It is hoped to commence with the project to restore and rewild the Southfields Open Space early in the New Year, possibly February or March, weather dependant. What day of the month and times of the sessions will be decided by the volunteer group, when formed. Tools and equipment will be provided, as will protective gloves. All we are looking for hopefully, is a couple of hours at each session. Everyone can do as much or as little as they feel able to.

Plans for the area once the initial clearing has been completed are to leave some areas completely natural and encourage pollinators and butterflies. Also to create some mulched pathways within the site to enable walking along those, with the pathways requiring minimal

maintenance. It is also being considered to plant a community Orchard within the site when appropriate and cleared, thus creating a natural green space to be enjoyed by those wishing to use it. No dogs will be allowed in the area, in line with Torridge District Council's policy on public open spaces.

Everyone is welcome, but for Health and Safety reasons volunteers must be aged over 18 years old.

If you would like to volunteer, help or simply find out more, members of the council will be hosting a morning meeting at the Committee room in the Village Hall on Saturday the 8th of February between 10.30 and 11.30 for a chat and cup of tea or coffee. Please come along if you can, we would be happy to see you and hear any suggestions you might like to contribute.

A plea for hedgehogs!

'Our Bridgerule hedgehogs are desperate for food from March to October/November but because the weather was mild they were still feeding in **December.** They're happy to eat bird fat pellets bought in big boxes from B&M - they tend to ignore tinned dog food which is recommended but always worth a try we also put out water in dog bowls - and it's great to see them drink from these. They feed just 2' from our glass doors each night - lovely to watch and we've had as many as 6 visits in one evening before 11.00 pm - and know they come during the night having set up a night camera. Usually they hibernate about October/November and need to be 450G in weight (1 lb) to survive the cold. If it's mild weather in **February** they could be seen foraging but by March they are really hungry and need to find food again. June is the month when the female can have 4 -5 young (hoglets) - and by July there could be more babies. If hedgehogs are born in **September** their chances of surviving the winter is slight. We've had baby hedgehogs about 5" long visit us and they are just adorable to watch.

Please if you can be kind to hedgehogs.

GRANTS - AVAILABLE TO HELP

GOVERNMENT SUPPORT FUND TORRIDGE DISTSRICT COUNCIL

In line with previous versions of the scheme the purpose of the grant is to provide support to households experiencing hardship due to the ongoing cost of living crisis. The grants will be available to help people in need to buy food, pay essential utility bills or meet other essential living or housing costs. Previous assistance has already allowed people to purchase clothing, blankets, and fund boiler servicing or repairs during the winter months. Applications can also be made to meet the cost of purchasing or repairing white goods such as fridges, freezers and ovens, which might otherwise currently be beyond the means of struggling households.

Access to the fund will once again be via a form, with initial applications being processed by the council's partner and local charity organisation, Encompass. The application form link will be available on Torridge District Council's website by clicking on the "Cost of living Help" icon on the main landing page and then the "Household Support Fund" link. Alternatively, people can contact Encompass through their website or by telephone if they do not have access to the internet on 01271 371499.

Derril Water Solar Park Update

We are pleased to report the progress of the ongoing Derril Water project. About 20% of the panels have now been installed. The structural work that will support the panels is advancing well, with about 85% completion. The substation buildings' foundation works are finished, and we've started con-

struction of one upper building.

The transformer foundations are progressing, with concrete pouring underway for two of them. Excavations for the other five transformers' foundations are ongoing, accompanied by load bearing tests. The installation of ducts and cables is also underway.



Deliveries of solar modules are ongoing and managed by Ethical Power to align with the installation schedule, minimising the need for large storage areas. Cable deliveries are expected to be complete by mid-January, with all necessary cables for the current stage of construction already on site.

Please note that the site will be closed for construction works during the festive period from December 24th to January 3rd. Security arrangements will continue to be in place during this period.

In January we will continue with cable installation and trenching, the construction of the MV switchgear foundation, and the substation buildings. Panel installation and deliveries to the site will also continue.

Remember, Derril Water Solar Park is Ripple Energy's first exciting shared solar project in the UK. Members not only benefit from the clean energy that will be generated but actually own this project. Airline and Holiday Booking Scams

Now is the time of year many will be booking a holiday away and scammers are well aware it provides a perfect opportunity to steal from you as families look for cheap holiday deals.

Beware of fake websites, phishing emails, and deceptive booking practices.

Scammers create websites that mimic legitimate airlines, offering heavily discounted tickets. Be cautious of prices that seem too good to be true. Fraudsters send emails claiming to be from airlines, asking for personal and financial information. Legitimate airlines will never request sensitive info via an unsolicited email.

Scammers pose as travel agencies or booking platforms, offering "exclusive deals" or "error fares." Be wary of sites with poor reviews or unclear refund policies. Fraudsters claim your flight has been cancelled and demand payment for rebooking or cancellation fees.

Red Flags to Watch Out For:

- 1. Unusually low prices
- 2. Limited-time offers or urgency to book
- 3. Poor website design or grammatical errors
- 4. Lack of clear refund policies
- Requests for personal or financial information via email or phone



To avoid airline scams book flights directly with the airline to ensure authenticity.

Check reviews, ratings, and refund policies before using third-party booking platforms.

Ensure the website you're using is legitimate by checking for official airline logos and secure payment systems.

Never respond to emails claiming to be from airlines, and never provide sensitive information.

Pay with credit cards, which offer better protection against fraud than debit cards or other payment methods.

Report any suspicious activity to your credit card company and ask them to put a watch on your account for unusual transactions. Banks have such systems in place as it is in their interest to stop scammers as it is the buyers.

Chasing a good or cheap deal can lead to very expensive disappointments and the last thing you would want is to arrive at the airport or your destination only to find you have actually been scammed!

As always remember, if a deal seems too good to be true, it most probably is.

Now that Christmas and the New Year is out of the way, let's hope that 2025 is better than what we have had.

My commiserations to those who have suffered from storm Darragh. Our damage was minimal and now put right. Not so others. On the other hand I am pleased that the editor, our Sheila Cholwill, has been presented with her British Empire Medal.

Now back to more criminal matters. I can hardly believe that an elderly couple have been deceived into handing over thousands of pounds worth of Euros and UK notes to scammers at their own door. But it is true.

Please please don't believe anyone who phones you about problems with your bank account, Amazon account, or trouble with your broadband or Microsoft. It's all lies. Even if the number is one you recognise, it's not who they say they are.

And worse, if the caller or text message or email claims to be a family member, doubt it straightaway. Especially if the supposed family member claims to have had to get a different device, and then asks for money. That is the clincher. Don't believe it. Use a number you know to be true.

If you have any concerns over a bank problem, ring 159 and get through to your own bank's fraud department

However, if you do believe an incoming call is from who they say they are, express regret and say that you will phone them on the number you know to be correct - then put the phone down. Don't take the number from them.

Wait 10-15 minutes, just the time for a cuppa, before using your number. Can I say finally, keep your goods to yourself - lock things up - doors, cars, windows, sheds, garages. Why leave them unlocked? Get outside lights that illuminate when approached. Don't leave your house looking empty. Ask your neighbours to help with curtains and lights.

But if you do spot something suspicious - call 999.
