St Bridget's Church Tower Restoration Progress



The repairs to the Church Tower are well underway, and we're hoping to have everything done before the end of November. The main work is to repoint all of the masonry on the Tower, removing the old lime mortar and replacing it with new. To cure properly the lime mortar has to dry out slowly, which is why the scaffolding is covered up and the contractors are using wetted blankets to keep everything moist.

The other key part of the work is to pump grout into the voids in the Tower; although it looks like it's made of solid blocks of masonry it's actually two walls with a cavity in between that's filled with rubble, a bit like 15th Century cavity wall insulation! Over time, water has seeped in, displacing or eroding the rubble, and filling these gaps with grout is vital for the tower's stability.

When the builders started on the top of the tower they were surprised to find that one of the pinnacles (the small turrets at the top) was starting to come away from the rest of the tower. Investigation revealed that it had been struck by lightning in the 1940s, blown off the tower and crashed through the roof of the Church. It's now been firmly attached back in place, and hopefully that's the last of the surprises that our 600 year old Church has for us!

New UK laws aimed at protecting children online

Regulating harmful content online came into effect on July 25, 2025. These laws, part of the Online Safety Act, require online platforms to implement measures to prevent children from accessing harmful content, including pornography, self-harm material, and other age-inappropriate content. Key aspects are:

Child Protection:

"Highly effective age assurance" must be applied.

Harmful Content Regulation:

Harmful content, i.e. self-harm, suicide and eating disorders must be monitored.

Transparency and Control:

Greater transparency on content to give users more control over what they see.

Enforcement:

Greater enforcement powers given to Ofcom to regulate content.

Age Verification:

Pornography sites must use robust age verification apps.

Parents and Children:

Parents to have more tools to protect children online.

Adult Users:

Adult users to have more control over available content.

Potential for Blocked Content:

Some websites may be blocked for UK users.

Evolving Technology:

The effectiveness of age verification tools to be monitored. However, the use of VPNs can bypass age verification measures as logging into foreign websites and the dark web is relatively easy. Many websites have little care on who views its content only that it brings in advertising revenue.

Some of these regulations may also breach personal data privacy laws and may not be applied as they can breach the data protection act! (that law may need to be changed).

The new laws mean well, but the law of unintentional consequences is apparent.

Talk about locking the stable door after the horse has bolted, the government is so far behind the curve, many of these laws will have no effect on tech savvy kids!! The new laws also affect what you may write on social media any breach of these laws can result in a criminal prosecution, be very careful, voicing a simple opinion can be life changing and you won't just be waving goodbye to freedom of speech.



The sneakiest ones sit in front of a computer and perform Scams. Persuading people to part with their money whether they realise it on not. The latest scam I have heard of is the phone Sim-card swap. If you are on social media sites, if you have had the mishap to have fallen for a phishing expedition, or have been part of a data breach by said criminals, and have parted with information about yourself, it is possible your smart phone number could be pinched. Then swapped to a different Sim-card and, Hey Presto you are not you - but the fraudster is. Everything on your phone is theirs. Of course, all they really want is your money, from bank account or credit/debit card details.

So - 'who you gonna call?' 159 and Action Fraud 0300 123 2040. Then your provider and let them know this really is you. Good idea to set up a special code word, name or number, so that they know when it is you. Not kept in the phone!

Don't fall for the friendly face that responds to your plea for a loan. Very possibly a Loan Shark. Try calling Torridge District Council on 01271 371 499 for the Household Support Fund. Holsworthy food bank is 01271 377077.

Are we getting another Indian Summer for the late caravans and motorhomes to visit around us? Be careful out there doing the essential shopping and elsewhere and in the home, keeping purses, bags and phones safe. Don't leave things on view in your vehicle. Have an eye open for peculiar behaviour if strangers are about and phone 999 if something criminal is happening, or Crimestoppers on 0800 555111 to report anonymously. Be part of your neighbourhood, watching, as the meerkats so nearly said.

Derril Water Solar Park Update

The works at Derril Water are steadily nearing completion as the team are carrying out 'hot commissioning' of the equipment now that there is a connection to the grid. Once that commissioning is completed and NGED (the grid company for the area) have approved the final tests, then the solar park will start to export power to the grid.

In parallel with that work the various communications systems are being set up which will enable remote control of the system and full data acquisition. We will use this data to let the Derril Water Coop members see how much power their solar park is generating.

We are also nearing completion of the installation of the security system which will be remotely monitored 24/7.

As the majority of the ground works have completed we will shortly level off and reseed the disturbed areas of ground so that the soil is stabilised and the grassland moves towards a more biodiverse composition in accordance with the ecological management plan for the site.






